

Environmental Footprint for the 2009 Annual Report

This entire annual report is printed on Neenah Conservation® which is made from 100 percent post-consumer fiber and processed without chlorine which saves 95 trees, 2,643 lbs. of solid waste, 45,538 gallons of water, 9,040 lbs. of air emissions and 9,040 lbs. of emissions compared to using virgin fiber paper.

The soy and vegetable oil-based inks used to print the report are 91 percent free of volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

The printer, University Lithographers, is a Michigan member of the Great Printer Project, a national, cooperative effort to make pollution prevention a standard practice in the lithographic printing industry.

Both the paper manufacturer and the printer are chain-of-custody certified by the Forest Stewardship Council.
